The Maker Sauvignon Blanc

9.5 / –

The palate has ripe passionfruit, stonefruit and hints of green capsicum. The wine finishes well with sweetness and lingering fresh acidity.

Volcanic Hills Sauvignon Blanc

Long persistent palate weight with a clean lime acidity, refreshingly zingy and luscious with a crisp finish. Made right here in Rotorua.

Stonecroft Organic Sauvignon Blanc

The Maker Pinot Gris

Full flavoured wine with tropical fruits of rock melon and lychee. The wine finishes with fruit sweetness and cleansing acidity.

Volcanic Hills Pinot Gris

A subtle soft richness, overlying honey and golden delicious apples, leads to an excellent structure, fleshy nectarine lead by fine acidity, a degree of spiciness and a refreshing dry finish. Made right here in Rotorua.

Millton Te Arai Organic Rosé

Made from Syrah with a squeeze of Malbec and a little lift of Viognier. Fresh wild berry characters and a dash of spice and aroma to enliven your senses.

Momo by Seresin Organic Rosé

Dry and delicate, showcasing red fruits characteristics of Pinot Noir, with the natural ferment adding a touch of spice and depth to the palate.

The Maker Merlot

9.5 / –

This unique blend is a complex, aromatic wine with black Doris plum notes and subtle hints of oak and tannins. The ripe berry flavours of the Merlot are complemented by the fragrant and approachable nature of Viognier.

Stonecroft Organic Ruhanui Merlot Cabernet Sauvignon

Dense black fruit flavours with blackcurrant and blackberry, a touch of cedar and a good tannic structure.

Crazy by Nature Organic Cosmo Red

11.0 / 46.0

This gorgeous wine is a field blend of Malbec, Syrah and Viognier. There is a dark leather and black pepper with a tingling aroma of lifted spice, unique to this wine and its own natural surroundings. The taste is dense and alive with mint, chocolate, Asian spice, and the warmth of a feather pillow for a fatigued head.

Millton La Cote Organic Pinot Noir

– / 52.0

A bright fruited, expressive nose, with notes of dark cherry, juniper berry and an intriguing hint of fennel and Manuka flower. There is a savoury taste with firm tannins and ripe fruit finishing with a lively mineral edge to balance.

Volcanic Hills Pinot Noir

A rich round almost gumminess, with excellent structure and concentration lead by fine acidity, plump tannins and a quantity of savoury spice offering a lasting elegant finish.

Stonecroft Undressed Organic Syrah

Dark fruit flavours with blackberry and redcurrant, and notes of black olive and pepper. It has a smooth finish and well integrated tannins. 'Undressed' refers to no added sulphur.

The Wineries and Breweries

Volcanic Hills Winery Set up in 2009 using borrowed winery space, they opened the Tasting Room with a gorgeous view overlooking Lake Rotorua, at the top of the Skyline Gondola in 2012. The winery at the base of the Gondola opened for the 2013 winemaking vintage. You'd be right in thinking there are no wine grapes in Rotorua! People often wonder why they are there. By being where the people are (both domestic and international visitors), they have brought the wine to the people, often saving a long drive to traditional wine regions. This also allows them to pick and choose where the grapes come from, not restricting us to the loyalty of one region. We get to choose the best we believe each region has to offer, make our wines in Rotorua and share them with you.

The Millton Vineyard The motto- Grown, not made. Millton Vineyards & Winery specialises in growing fine wine from estate grown grapes sourced from their own single vineyards. For 30 years these grapes have been grown in the traditional manner using biodynamic techniques. This involves growing the grapes without the use of herbicides, insecticides, systemic fungicides or soluble fertilisers. It incorporates the use of special herbal, mineral and animal preparations and teas and includes a deep understanding of the complex cosmic rhythms which affect these daily activities.

Stonecroft Wines At Stonecroft, they seek to express through their wines the unique character of their vineyards and each vintage. The intention is to make wines which are intense, full-bodied, elegant and fruit-driven, but capable of significant bottle development. The ability of their wines to improve in bottle has been demonstrated over more than 20 years, with many of the early examples still drinking well. The total production is very small; with around 3,500 cases produced annually. Both the vineyards and the winery are certified organic

Seresin Inspired by Michael Seresin's own connections and interests, they are a new world winery with an old world approach - they are in no hurry when it comes to their wines. They let the wild yeasts that live in the vineyard ferment the grape juice into wine. Working this way does take a little more time, but they get wines with added savouriness and with more mouth-watering textures and flavours. They also show a unique sense of place. They let all of the wines spend time in barrel or bottle before release. 'Good things come to those who wait.'

Three Boys At Three Boys Brewery they personally tend each small-scale brew, right from selecting the best malt and hops until it leaves the brewery. Their beers are a living product; not filtered and not pasteurized - just as nature intended. Their aim is simple: finest quality beer, finest possible taste. The beers are brewed, bottled, and canned on site so you can guarantee quality and freshness every time.

Peckham's They strive to make cider with integrity, without compromise, with no short cuts, and with minimal intervention. The ciders are made from 100% fresh juice, and are made only in autumn with tree ripened fruit. They take their time, slow fermenting and ageing our ciders for at least six months. The fruit is hand harvested before being milled and pressed into rich, intensely aromatic, cider juice. Each type of apple has specific characteristics, and varieties are carefully blended to yield the appropriate acidity levels and balanced tannins. A few varieties are well balanced enough to make "single variety" (SV) ciders
